School Gateway

If you are having problems accessing your app and/or are not receiving emails, please use the following steps to resolve the issue.

Apps: Log out and log back in again. If you have forgotten your pin you can request a new pin using the 'Forgotten your pin?' link.

Emails: EE and Orange users may find they are no longer receiving emails. If this is the case, please advise the school office confirming your email address and we will help you to resolve the issue.

Military Parade by the Royal Anglian Regiment – 2nd July

Broxbourne Borough Council granted Honorary Freeman status to the Royal Anglian Regiment. On Sunday 2nd July, the Regiment will be exercising their new right to march through the Borough with colours flying, bands playing, drums beating and bayonets fixed.
