Parking

Please, for the safety of the children, do not park in the staff car park unless you have express permission from the school. This week we almost had a collision in our car park owing to some careless driving. If you do have permission to park on our premises (for reasons of disability etc.) please ensure that the entrance/exit gate is closed behind you, once you have passed through.

Attendance

We are increasingly receiving requests for, or notifications of, holiday leave. Please consider that a constant 90% attendance rate equates to one missed day every two weeks and one missed year between Y1 and Y11 (from Key Stage 1 to the child's GCSE year). This has a significant negative effect on a child's learning and does have implications for their future. There is a clear link between poor attendance at school and lower academic achievement. Lower academic achievement can reduce a person's earning capacity in later life. Please consider carefully any requests for leave of absence.



Set out on the next page, is a list of children who are to be congratulated for having 100% attendance i.e. not having missed one half day of school, in the spring term. At the end of the year when you receive your child's report you will also receive their percentage attendance for the year. If your child's attendance dips below 95% it will start to affect their chances of doing well academically. We do, of course, understand unavoidable illness where you have to keep your child at home!
