Bottle Line for our School Fete, Sunday 8th July

Tomorrow, the 3rd of July we will be having a non-uniform day when we would ask you to bring in a bottle for our bottle line, as opposed to a donation. The bottles will then be raffled on the bottle stall at the school fete which this year is on Sunday the 8th of July from 12 p.m. to 4 p.m.

'Meet the teacher' – Wednesday 4th July

Our annual 'Meet the teacher' evening will take place on Wednesday the 4th of July from 5pm until 7pm. This is an opportunity for you to visit your child's new teacher and hopefully have any concerns and queries answered. The children's books will not be out in trays, as this only happens at parents' consultation evenings.

Non-Uniform Day for Key Stage 2 pupils only – 13th July

As part of our French day, there will be French language workshops for all children in Key Stage 2. All KS2 children may dress in the colours of the French flag (red, white and blue) on Friday the 13th of July.

Scooters and Bicycles in school

Whilst we encourage children to cycle to school, they are not allowed to cycle within our school grounds. This is for the safety of all our children. Please do not allow your child to cycle in school. All children with bicycles and scooters should dismount before the school gates and walk their cycles once inside. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

Jewellery

Children are not allowed jewellery in school. This has been the case for many years and we would be grateful for your cooperation in ensuring that your child does not come to school wearing earrings and/or other items of jewellery.

Studio steps

Each morning, a number of children are climbing over the studio steps as if they were a piece of play equipment. They are not to be used for this purpose and your child may be injured by continuing to 'play' on the steps. Children who persist in climbing over the steps before school will be asked to miss a breaktime as a consequence.
