

Classes 1P & 1G Newsletter - Summer Term 2021

We would like to welcome you all back to a new term at Fairfields.

Once again classes 1P and 1G will be following a parallel curriculum throughout the term.

This term the children will complete two topics - the first half term is all about castles. The second half term the children will be learning all about Superheroes, including real life Superheroes. The topic will encompass science, history, geography and music. The topics will involve lots of practical elements to enhance the children's learning such as creating their own 3D castles, visiting a Motte and Bailey castle and taking part in their own sports day (fingers crossed!)

Your children will continue to bring home weekly spellings to be tested the following week. We would appreciate it if you could use the "Look, say, cover, write, check" method for learning these.

Please continue to hear your child read as often as possible. The children will all be heard read by a teaching assistant once a week, and their books will be changed if there is a comment written in their reading records from an adult. The children will be receiving two books per week, a fiction or non-fiction book with a phonics based book. Please continue to read other texts at home too as much as possible. This should include non-fiction, fiction and poetry.

Please make sure **all** items of clothing are clearly labelled in a permanent pen. This will ensure that any lost items will easily find their way back to their rightful owner! Please ensure that your child's shoes are relatively easy to put on and take off so that time is not wasted. Please practise buttoning and zipping items of clothing at home with your child as they are required to do this independently.
